Introduce a little bit of fun at your workplace, group or club by incorporating Footy Colours Day fines into your celebration!

## HOW TO PLAY

Firstly, set an amount of time you wish to play for. Then, create a list of actions or behaviours in which people will be fined (check out examples below for inspiration).

Next, appoint a group Fines Master. Throughout the game, the role of the fines master is to record and 'sheriff' the groups fines. The Fine Master also has the authority to hand out 'surprise fines' for any additional behaviour they deem worthy of a fine.

At the end of the designated time, or however regularly you choose, the Fines Master will read out each fine. The recipient of a fine has to pay a set amount to your Footy Colours Day Collection. The Fine can be a fixed amount or can vary depending on the extremity of the offense

## **EXAMPLE FINES**

- Someone is late to work, a meeting or a video call.
- Select common phrases amongst the group, which are not allowed to be said.
- Designate an 'Illegal' colour (i.e. purple) – If someone wears the chosen colour throughout the game they will receive a fine.
- Allocate a type of food which is not allowed to be eaten in the office
- Someone mentions their footy teams victory over the weekend
