Footy Colours Day - Our School





Year Level: 7 - 8

Learning Focus

Students use their creativity to design a poster to promote Footy Colours Day.

Learning Intention

We are learning to:

Use different media, digital and online formats to promote a school event (Footy Colours Day).

Success Criteria

I can:

Select from different media, digital and online formats to plan and design artwork and other visual resources to promote Footy Colours Day throughout my school.



Students use their creativity and select from different media, digital and online formats to plan and design artwork and other visual resources to promote Footy Colours Day.

Students are encouraged to be creative in their design and share their ideas explaining why they used selected media, digital and online formats to promote Footy Colours Day.



Key information should include:

- Brief explanation describing what is Footy Colours Day.
- Why we are raising money on Footy Colours Day.
- Date of Footy Colours Day and any other activities that students could be involved in on Footy Colours Day (ie. Footy Clinic or Longest Kick competition).

Students could design a professional-styled poster or similar artwork that could be placed in their classroom or in a prominent place in the school such as the entrance or reception area foyer to promote *Footy Colours Day*.

Note: Students could use use their choice of digital resources and other online communication tools such as a class blog or a shared online learning forum used by the school or classroom teacher.
